 - 2. No team will be allowed home field advantage in regional playoffs.
 - 3. Regional competition will be at UNCC and High School fields within the city limits.
 - 4. Hotels may be located closer to venues.
 - 5. Cost to attend regional events will remain the same. The region will consider a reduction in fee for students.
 - 6. The Region will review allowing more than 5 coaches to have free admittance to event.
 - 7. The Region will look into and provide drop deadlines on rosters for participation in regional events.
 - 8. Participation of teams in non Pop Warner events – as soon as the season is over, you are no longer a Pop Warner team and not prevented to play as a team in a non Pop Warner sponsored event. You are not covered under Pop Warner insurance and you must pull the Pop Warner patches off of the uniforms.
 - 9. All CFF generated agenda items passed except for TM playing both ways rule.

 - 11. Insurance premiums are the same as last year. Highly recommended to use the Pop Warner insurance offering.
