Items Covered:

1. Spirit Update from Christy:
 - a. 'Amazing' Clinic Weekend - 250+ coaches in attendance.
 - b. Make-up Clinic held in Charlotte – Aug. 4+5.
 - c. Cheer Directors Mtg. to be held 8/19- review/certify books.
2. Scholastics Update from Mike:
 - a. CFF scholastic coverage will be split by region.
 - b. Coaches will be held responsible for scholastics.
 - c. Association Scholastic Coordinators are there to manage the documentation process.
3. Roster Software Updates:
 - a. Divisional Qualification: All associations should enter all kids at the same division then change the specific team's divisional declaration once the team has been allocated and players assigned.
 - b. GPA: Enter 2.0 or 2.5 if kids are academically eligible or for upper classifications the exact percentage must be entered. Enter 1.0 if determined to be academically ineligible or is insufficient report card.
 - c. Scholastic Eligibility Form must be signed by Parent and Head Coach. – School Official not required.

- d. Interim reports are due between 9/25 and 10/15 and must be signed by School Official.
4. Dues: National, Regional and League dues are due to League Treasurer by August 10, 2007.
5. Certification for weight, scholastics and all Pop Warner Forms will begin the week of August 13th, 2007.
6. Rule Books online password – jt8929
7. Mike Baldwin announced Tiny Mite updates. CFF will pilot a program for Tiny Mite rosters to increase to a maximum of 28 players. CFF will enforce a 15 play mandatory play count for Tiny Mite division.
8. Rule books were distributed and updates reviewed.
9. Each association then announced team counts for football and cheer.
10. Christy announced that Tri-County has been awarded the host duties for the cheer exhibition Sept. 23.
