Items Covered:

1. Welcome new members: Sheri Taylor recognized as Cary Cheer Commissioner.
2. Open Meeting and welcome. Reviewed and accepted meeting minutes from April 2007.
3. Jamboree update presented by Tom Goodwin. Tom stated upon input from organizations that the league would adopt a new format for preseason/jamboree play. Playing time will be expanded to 45 minute sessions with more time given to coaching instruction during exhibition at all levels. The league will also split the jamboree to multiple associations.
4. Tom also presented an update on the Challenger Division.
 - a. CFF league to break division by age:
 - 8, 9 and 10 year olds
 - 11, 12 and 13 year olds
 - b. Sally McCormick to generate a press release to make a formal public announcement of the new division of play.
 - c. Coaches do not need special certification or requirements.
 - d. Tom will monitor the enrollment of the division.
5. Mike Baldwin discussed the new roster software.
 - a. Mike will assign each Football and Cheer Commissioner rights to each association.
 - b. Association Commissioners will then be able to assign jobs and roles to their organizations.
 - c. Active Networks will NOT allow database or spreadsheet conversions.
 - d. Live Training to be held at June meeting.
 - e. Link on National Pop Warner web-site to League 1 roster software demo.
